ORDER

SSUS Act 1994 lays down that in making appointment for direct recruitment, the University shall observe reservation rules of KS and SS Rules 1958. According to Section 32 of SSUS Act, the rules apply to all teaching and non-teaching posts. It is said that the University shall apply the Rules mutatatis and mutandis Statutes 3 in Chapter III of the SSUS Statute 1997 further explains that the University shall observe the provision of Rules 14 (a), (b) and (c) and Rule 15,16 and 17 of the KS and SSR 1958 as amended from time to time.

The present statute do not suggest any method of reservation ie, category wise or department wise for appointment of teaching staff. As such at present, in making appointments of teachers in the University, each category of post in each department is taken as a unit for applying reservation.

Vide paper read as 1st above, the Government of Kerala asked the University to consider each category of teachers in all the departments in the University as a unit and to apply the reservation rules. The post of lecturer will be one unit, those of Reader another and those of professors the other. Thus the University shall pool together the vacant posts belonging to each category in three rosters, namely one each for Lecturers, Readers and for Professors properties of the Departments where the vacancy arters.

Vide paper read as 2nd above, the University has constituted a committee to study how the category wise reservation could be implemented for teaching staff of the University and to submit a report along with the detailed practical modus operandi of implementing the category wise reservation in appointment of teachers.

Vide paper read as above the Syndicate has considered the report and resolved to

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor to implement the following

- (a) The revised reservation rules of apportioning the vacanties on the category wise instead of deportment wise, shall be adopted.
- (b) All teaching posts shall be categorized in to(a) Professor (b) Reader (c) Lecturer for the purpose of application of reservation as mandated in the SSUS Act and KS & SSR.
- Separate Roster shall be maintained for each category of posts.
- (d) Details relating to the posts shall be entered in the roster on the order of dates of occurrence of vacancy.
- (e) If vecancies in a category occur in different departments on the same day, the alphabetical order of the Departments shall be considered for determining the order of entering into the roster.
- (f) In case more vacancies than one occur in the same department, the alphabetical order of the subjects of specialization if any be reclained for the entry into the roster.
- (g) Vacancy for a post arrives by way of retirement, relinquishment, death of a incumbent, or by creation of new post.
- (h) When a teacher promoted under CAS relinquishes the higher post he holds, the post shall revert back to the original lower post. The date of arising of the vacancy shall be the date of reversion to the original post.
- (i) In case of shifting of a post from one Department to another Department the nature (ie. whether open or reserved and if reserved which community) of the post shall remain the same as that of the post in the Department/from which the shifting is made.
- (i) In making appointments to the existing vacancies as on the date of the order, the SC/ST communities shall be compensated first by isolating them from the list.

Orders are issued accordingly.
